This specification describes the City of Lompoc minimum requirements for one (1) new, unused 2018 Dump Truck 26,000 GVWR, 73,000 GCWR.

For example; 2016 Freightliner M2 106 with Scelzi 5-7 yard Dump Body or equivalent will meet the requirements of this specification].

Vehicle shall be supplied with all equipment and accessories indicated as standard equipment in the manufacturer's published literature (or web site).

Optional equipment necessary to meet the minimum requirements of this specification shall be included and covered under manufactures warranty.

All applicable permits and licenses shall be provided.

Clearance lights and reflectors shall be Grote LED's and furnished in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and Department of Transportation legal requirements.

"2016 Freightliner M2 106 with Scelzi 5-7 yard Dump Body (page 47 - 2018 catalog) or equivalent will meet the requirements of this specification)."

Dump Body 5-7 yard 10 foot. Constructed 10 gauge sides and front. 3 corrugations in front panel. 4" flange boxed top rail. Sloped running boards closed at bottom. 45 degree sloped rub rail. Horizontal center side braces. Radius front corner posts with recessed clearance lights on lower post. Safety body support prop with easy operator access and storage. Swivel hinged rear mud flaps with anti-sail and fold up provision. Sloped half cab shield.

Light plugs shall be wired for tail lights and combination stop-turn signal lights. Glad hands location shall prevent contact with dump body while dump body is in use.

Full underbody NETA Class 50 Rating at 17 ton lifting capacity. 6" I.D. cylinder with 2.5" chromed shaft. Dump body to have a 50 degree effective dump angle. Full double acting cylinder hydraulic power or positive control throughout the dumping cycle.

All regular pre-delivery and warranty services shall be provided, including front End aligned, tires balanced, and headlights properly adjusted.

All other standard equipment shall be provided. All equipment shall be manufacturer installed unless otherwise specified.

Safety equipment shall be provided including:

- first aid kit,
- road side safety triangles and

LICENSING:

Vendor shall register the vehicle with the California Department of Motor Vehicles and provide EXEMPT license plates.

One each complete operating, maintenance, electrical and service manuals for the truck chassis.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ISSUANCE OF BID: This bid request creates no obligation on the part of the City and the City reserves the unconditional right, at its option, to either reject all bids or waive any irregularities or informalities therein.

BID SUBMISSION: Bids must be submitted on bid forms provided herein, completed and signed, in a sealed envelope showing on the outside of the envelope the name of bidder, bid title, and date and time of opening. Prices shall be printed in ink or typewritten. No erasures are permitted. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections printed adjacent and initialed in ink by person signing the bid. Bidders must complete and return the Compliance/Deviation column of the specification page(s) in order to be considered.

BID VALIDITY/WITHDRAWAL: Prices shall remain valid for ninety (90) days from date of opening and be inclusive. Bids submitted may be withdrawn by written request received BEFORE the hour set for opening. No bidder may withdraw their bid after the time set for opening.

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS: When applicable, bidders shall conform to California Labor Code, Section 6360 and Title 8 CAC, Section 339 and 5194 and submit MSDS on hazardous substances with bid.

LOWEST APPARENT BIDDER SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS: The lowest apparent bidder may be required to submit the following:

- a) Proof of authorized distributorship
- b) A sample or demonstration of any product/unit offered. Samples and/or demonstration must be free of expense to the City.
- c) City Business Tax number
- d) PUC permit
- e) Insurance requirements

- f) Proof of driver training on hazardous substances

COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: All bids shall comply with current federal, state and local laws relative thereto, including applicable Federal and State Occupation Safety and Health laws and that Seller will indemnify and hold the Buyer harmless for any failure to so conform.

NEW/UNUSED AND LATEST MODEL: Bidders shall provide pricing on new and unused items, material and/or units specified unless otherwise stated in specifications.

BRAND NAMES: Brand names are used to establish a level of quality only. Bids will be considered for any brand which meets or exceeds the quality of the specifications listed for any item. Bids that deviate from the specifications must be clearly defined. The City will have the sole right to determine whether an alternate is acceptable.

F.O.B. POINT AND SHIPPING CHARGES: All prices shall be quoted F.O.B. destination Lompoc, California. Any and all shipping, handling and freight charges shall be shown separately unless otherwise noted on bid form.

LAWS GOVERNING CONTRACT: The contract shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of California and the County of Santa Barbara is the only appropriate forum for any litigation.

In the event a suit or action is instituted arising out of any contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to receive, in addition to its cost, such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as to attorney's fees and costs.

TAXES (FEDERAL EXCISE/SALES OR

USE/LOCAL PREFERENCE: The City is exempt from Federal Excise Tax. All taxes, if applicable, shall be shown on bid form page. ALL TAXES; Sales, Use and Local Preference will be a consideration in bid evaluation.

MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISES: It is the policy of the City that minority business enterprises shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the City's bidding requirements.

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY: It is the policy of the City to promote the full realization of equal employment opportunity.

COOPERATIVE PURCHASING: The successful bidder may agree to extend all terms and conditions to other tax-supporting agencies upon their request. These agencies will issue their own purchase order and be billed directly by supplier. Bidders agreement or disagreement must be stated on bid form and will not effect bid evaluation.
