#### Frequently Asked Questions



How do I dispose of large, bulky items?

The City offers several programs to pick-up large items, such as furniture, appliances, mattresses and other bulky items. Large items can also be selfhauled to the Lompoc Landfill.

What materials can I haul to the Lompoc Landfill for recycling or disposal?

The Landfill accepts common trash, tree & yard clippings, wood waste, concrete, asphalt, top soil, tires, scrap metal, large appliances, electronic waste (anything with a cord or a battery), anti-freeze, car batteries, used oil and oil filters. The Landfill is located at the south end of Avalon St.

# What items am I prohibited from placing in my refuse container?

It is against the law to place hazardous waste such as paints, paint thinner, flammable liquids, cleaners, pesticides, oil filters, automotive fluids, aerosols, fluorescent tubes, batteries and electronic waste in your refuse container. 

### Regular Collection Schedule

The City provides weekly collection to single family residences and commercial businesses. Refuse, commingled recyclables, and green waste are all collected on the same day. To determine which day your household or business is serviced, please call the Solid Waste Division at (805) 875-8024 or visit our website.

To ensure your containers are serviced, please follow the guidelines below:

- ✓ Place containers out for collection by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.
- ☑ Ensure handles are facing your house.
- Allow at least 18 inches between containers and three feet from obstacles such as mail boxes, utility poles, and vehicles.
- ☑ Do not place hazardous materials, electronic wastes, dirt, rocks, concrete, or items that stick out of your container.

#### **Landfill Hours**

The Lompoc Landfill is open seven days per week, except for major holidays as listed in the Holiday Schedule to the right. Normal operating days/hours are as follows:

> **Monday - Friday** 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

**Saturdays & Sundays** 10:00 a.m. - 3:45 p.m.
