

# Vehicle Maintenance and Transit Operations Center Property Purchase



#### **Brief History of Action taken:**

- June 4, 2013 Use of Proposition 1B funds to develop new facility.
- October 15, 2013 Approved purchase agreement with Union Band for the former Weyrick Lumber Yard at 320 North "D" Street
- April 2014 Contract with IBI Group for needs analysis and programming phase of work.
- March 2015 Presented results of Relocation Analysis and received direction from Council that the combined Transit Operations and Fleet Maintenance Facility was the preferred option (Site Study 3)






# VEHICLES OFTEN STACKED 3 DEEP BLOCKING DRIVE ISLES AND OTHER DIVISION OPERATIONS




# SERVICE BAYS THAT ARE SMALLER THAN NEEDED TO SERVICE MANY VEHICLES INSIDE.

#### ITEMS TO CONSIDER BEFORE MAKING A DECISION:

- The preferred Site Plan #3 requires additional land acquisition. Staff has negotiated in good faith with the property owner to reach a willing buyer/willing seller agreement.
- The preferred Site Plan #3 meets the projected Transit and Fleet needs for the next 20 plus years and provides room for expansion if needed to meet the projected needs for the next 50 years.
- New facility will create enhanced security opportunities at both facilities.
- ➤ Keeping Transit Maintenance & Fleet Maintenance together at one facility creates the most efficient operation as mechanics, tools, and bays can all be shared.
