DOMESTIC SERVICE

<u>APPLICABILITY</u>

This schedule applies to domestic lighting, heating, cooking, and single phase domestic power service in single family dwellings and in flats and apartments separately metered by the Utility; to single phase service used in common for residential purposes by tenants in multi-family dwellings; and to all single-phase farm service on premises operated by the person whose residence is supplied through the same meter.

TERRITORY

The entire area served by the City of Lompoc Electrical Utility.

RATES

The following rates are effective with bills issued on and after the indicated dates:

This adopted rate schedule is subject to a monthly Power Cost Adjustment (PCA) calculation. The PCA charge will be updated monthly based on the average power cost calculated over the previous 12 months. The PCA will be implemented on 11/1/2025 and calculated each month thereafter.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. <u>Master Meters</u>

When applied to apartment houses or groups of apartments receiving service through one (master) meter, the minimum charge shall be multiplied by the number of residential dwelling units wired for service.

2. <u>Miscellaneous</u>

For customers who use service for only part of the year, this schedule is applicable only to an annual contract.

3. <u>Life Support Devices</u>

A residential customer who certifies in writing that regular use of a medical life support device, as defined below, is essential to maintain the life of a full-time resident of the household is eligible for the Tier 2 Energy Rate for the first 1,500 KWh of usage. Certification by a doctor of medicine or osteopathy licensed to practice medicine in the State of California that a particular device is necessary to sustain the user's life may be required.

A life support device is defined as any medical device requiring Utility supported energy for its operation that is regularly required to maintain the life of a person residing in a residential unit. The term includes respirators, iron lungs, hemodialysis

machines, suction machines, electric nerve stimulators, pressure pads and pumps, aerosol tents, electrostatic and ultrasonic nebulizers, compressors, IPPB machines and motorized wheelchairs. The term does not include therapeutic devices such as whirlpool pumps, heating pads, vaporizers, and humidifiers.

4. Space Heating

Residential customers with electric space heating as the principal source of home heating will be charged the Tier 2 Energy Rate for kilowatt usage from 326 to 1500 KWh during the seven (7) months of November through May, inclusive. The Tier 1 Energy Rate applies to the first 325 KWh of usage. These rates will be available following application by the customer and verification thereof by the City. Customers are eligible for this discount only if they were a customer of the City of Lompoc on December 31, 2007, the customer was receiving the discount as of December 31, 2007, and is currently receiving their service at the same address as they received service on December 31, 2007, with no lapse in service.
