Schedule No.A-12

General Service - Demand-Metered

<u>APPLICABILITY</u>

This schedule applies to polyphase alternating current service and to industrial, commercial and municipal service using a minimum of 25,000 kWh per monthly billing cycle, with a monthly demand or capacity greater than 100 kW during each monthly billing cycle.

Assignment to Schedule: If, in the judgment of the Utility, or its authorized employee, an account is expected to exceed 25,000 kWh per billing cycle for more than six months in a year, or to exceed 100 kW per billing cycle for more than six months in a year, the Utility has the option of placing the account on this schedule at the initiation of service. After initiation of service, changes to or from this schedule would follow criteria in ATTACHMENT 1 – General Conditions.

This schedule is not available for service when another commercial/industrial schedule is applicable.

TERRITORY:

The entire area served by the City of Lompoc Electrical Utility.

CHARGES:

The following charges are effective with the bills issued on and after those dates.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Basis for Demand Charge

The customer will be billed for demand according to the customer's "maximum demand" each month. The number of KVA used will be recorded over fifteen-minute intervals; the highest fifteen-minute average in the month will be the customer's maximum demand.

2. <u>Seasons</u>

The summer rate is applicable from May 1 through October 31; the winter rate is applicable from November 1 through April 30. When a billing period overlaps the two seasons, both the demand and energy charges will be prorated based upon the number of days of the billing cycle in each period.

3. <u>Prior Service</u>

Customers being served under this schedule prior to June 30, 1992, are not subject to the 25,000 kWh minimum requirements.

4. <u>Miscellaneous</u>

For customers who use service for only part of the year, this schedule is applicable only on an annual contract.
