Explanation of the City of Lompoc's Solid Waste Division New Collection Schedule

Collection of all trash, commingled recycling and greenwaste for single-family residents will now occur on the same day of the week.

Collection of commercial and multi-family customers will not be affected by this change.

Please place all containers in their normal collection location on the day specified below for your area:

Monday

Residents living north of North Avenue.

Tuesday

Residents living between North & College Avenues.

Thursday

Residents living between College & Ocean Avenues.

Friday

Residents living south of Ocean Avenue.

Greenwaste should be placed in your grey container with the GREEN lid and the word "Greenwaste" on the top.

Commonly Asked Questions

What is Greenwaste?

Greenwaste, sometimes called Yardwaste, is simply the grass clippings, leaves, weeds, small branches and similar debris generated by yardwork.

What kind of debris can NOT be placed in the Greenwaste Container?

Please help us keep the greenwaste container clean! NO plastic bags, garbage, household hazardous wastes, animal waste, dirt, rocks, food products, garden hoses, tires, flower pots, palm fronds, pampas grass, cactus, yucca or iceplants in this container.

What Happens if I Contaminate my Greenwaste Container?

Your sanitation driver will issue two warnings. If the container is found to be contaminated a third time, the greenwaste container will be removed, ending your greenwaste recycling opportunity.

When Do I Place My Container Out for Collection?

To assure pick-up the container must be placed out by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.

Where Do I Place My Container Out for Collection?

Please place your greenwaste container in the same location used for your regular refuse containers. If your container is located on the street, please make sure no vehicles are blocking access to your container.
