Program management and staff of our family resource center have recently undergone a full revision of client tracking systems and procedures, which have resulted in constructive and positive changes to the way we track client demographics. Perhaps the largest change was the determination to no longer track full and complete demographic data on every individual who seeks assistance from FRC. For many individuals and families who seek help at an FRC, their contact with staff is limited, one-time contact for information and referrals that does not extend to full case management services. Further many clients who eventually get information and referrals from FRC staff do so in an arena of community events or in other public formats where there is little to no privacy in which to discuss personal matters. In these cases, FRC staff have found that trying to track full demographic data on these â¿Â¿one-stopâ¿Â. one stopâ¿Â. one a critical barrier to services as clients can find the process of divulging all of their personal information not only intimidating but also frustrating. In light of this, FSAâ¿Â¿s Family now only tracking the full demographic histories of case managed families who have regular and sustained contact with one of FSAâÂ;Â;s Family Advocates. While we are still tracking the numbers of all client contacts at n FRC, we have discovered that limiting demographic tracking to case managed families is far more positive and effective way to track information in a way that doesnâ¿Â¿t become a barrier to service for families seeking help.

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The mentoring program continues to run smoothly. The agency has a fantastic stradigy for recruiting volunteers to reduce their client waiting list. Due to the combined efforts of the program & agency staff they were able to recruit enough volunteers to serve as many youth as the previous year. The agency has program fundraisers and host an event to honor the volunteers while participating in a simple engaging group of games and activities at a local park. The program is using an evaluation tool with surveys that reflects improvement in the participating youth mentored by the agency's trained, caring adult volunteers. Results show that 75% of youth improved their academic performance, 70% improved their attitude toward school, 87.5% of youth mentored have improved their ability to avoid substance abuse, 85.7% showed improved ability to avoid early parenting, and more then 75% of youth improved relationships with family, adults and peers.
