AMENDMENT 1 TO

CONTRACT FOR CLEAN AIR EXPRESS OPERATION SERVICES BETWEEN THE THE CITY OF LOMPOC

AND

STORER TRANSIT SYSTEMS

This AMENDMENT is entered into between the City of Lompoc, hereinafter referred to as "City", and Storer Transit Systems, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor", for the purpose of extending the current contract for operation services for the Clean Air Express interregional commuter transit service in Santa Barbara County.

1. Section 5 is Amended as follows:

5. <u>Term</u>

The term of this Agreement is from November 22, 2012 to 7:00 p.m. on <u>July 1, 2016</u> November 26, 2014. <u>One</u>, <u>Two one</u> year options may be exercised by City <u>Administrator</u> at the same terms as therein.

2. Section 8.B and C. is Amended as follows:

8. Indemnification and Insurance

8.B and C.

- B. Commercial General Liability Insurance in the minimum amounts indicated below, including, but not limited to, Contractual Liability Insurance, Products-Completed Operations Hazard, Personal Injury (including bodily injury and death), and Property Damage for liability arising out of CONTRACTED SERVICE PROVIDER's work operating the Clean Air Express. Said insurance shall have minimum limits for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability equal to the policy limits, but not less than \$10,000,000 \$5,000,000 each occurrence and \$5,000,000 \$10,000,000 aggregate.
- C. Automobile Liability Insurance against claims of Personal Injury (including bodily injury and death) and Property Damage covering all owned, leased, hired and non-owned vehicles used in the performance of providing the CAE, with minimum limits for Bodily Injury and Property Damage Liability equal to the policy limits, but not less than \$10,000,000 \$5,000,000 each occurrence

In all other respects, this MOU shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
