Lompoc Grammar School in 1886. It was built in the late 1870's and demolished in 1922. It was located at Chestnut and "H" St.




This picture is taken facing Northwest looking from Hickory and "L" St. The Junior High School in the foreground and the High School in the background.



An archive photo of the Civic Auditorium dated 1966, when it was given to the city.




The new Lompoc Grammar School in 1930. It was demolished in 1968 and El Camino School was built. This was also located at "H" St. and Chestnut.



A post card rendering of the first Lompoc High School. It cost one cent to send this post card.




A picture looking North from Olive Ave. at the first Lompoc High School Baseball Field and Industrial Arts Building.
