CITY 3. Adoption of Building Code Ordinance No. 1574(10).

Adopted Ordinance No. 1574(10) to include mandatory State building requirements in the Lompoc Municipal Code and streamline existing code provisions.

CITY 4. Final Acceptance of Project No. FY-09-S-6, 2010 Street Rehabilitation Project.

Accepted Project No. FY-09-S-6 as complete and instructed the City Clerk to file the required Notice of Completion regarding this project.

NEW BUSINESS:

CITY 5. Parking Violation Bail Schedule Adjustment.

Police Chief Timothy Dabney presented the staff report and recommendations.

Council Member Lingl asked Staff to clarify if the amount the City is obligated to pay to the State for each parking citation is due when the citation is issued or when the payment is received from the cited party. Chief Dabney explained the timeframe for remittance to the State is dependent on the type of citation issued.

Council Member Costa asked Chief Dabney to explain how the City's General Fund may be affected by the City's obligations to the County and State for each parking citation issued by the City of Lompoc. Chief Dabney stated the monies collected in parking violation bail penalties are deposited to the City's General Fund and the monies paid to the County and State are taken from the City's General Fund; this small increase in the parking violation penalty schedule will provide the amount needed to cover the added charge of The Trial Court Trust Fund as mandated by the State of California, without decreasing the City's General Fund.

<u>ACTION</u>: Motion/Second: <u>Costa/Lingl</u>. By a 4-0 vote (*Council Member Martner was absent*) the City Council approved Resolution No. 5688(11), rescinding Resolution No. 5571(09), which previously established a schedule of parking violation penalties for parking in accordance with procedures established by Vehicle Code Sections 40200, et seq., and provided for annual recalculation of the bail amounts based on increases in the Consumer Price Index (C.P.I.) of Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County, CA.

CITY/RDA 6. **Investment Policies of the City of Lompoc/Lompoc Redevelopment Agency.**

Management Services Director Brad Wilkie presented the staff report and recommendations.
