

RESOLUTION NO. 5688 (11)

**A Resolution Of The Council Of The City Of Lompoc,
County Of Santa Barbara, State Of California,
Establishing A Schedule Of Parking Violation Penalties For Parking
In Accordance With Procedures Established By Vehicle
Code Sections 40200, ET Seq.**

WHEREAS, in 1992, the State Legislature adopted AB408 (Chapter 1244, Statutes of 1992) which establishes procedures for the decriminalization of parking violations and transferred responsibilities for processing, adjudicating and collection of fees from the courts to cities and other issuing agencies (ref. Vehicle Code Sections 40200, et seq.); and

WHEREAS, Section 40203.5 of the Vehicle Code provided for the City Council of the jurisdiction where the notice of violation is issued to establish a schedule of parking penalties, parking violations, late payment penalties, administrative charges and other related charges for parking violations;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Lompoc Police Department is hereby authorized to process parking citations as civil penalties in accordance with the procedures contained in Vehicle Code Sections 40200, et seq; and

SECTION 2. The attached Exhibit "A" is hereby adopted as the schedule of parking penalties for violations of the parking regulations contained in the Lompoc City Code and the California Vehicle Code; and

SECTION 3. On July 1st of each year the rates will be adjusted by the Los Angeles-Riverside-Orange County, Ca CPI for the twelve months prior to July. The most current twelve-month information that is available from the U. S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Statistics as of June 30th prior to the rate change will be used. If the CPI for the referenced twelve months is a zero or a negative the rates will remain unchanged.

SECTION 4. Additional administrative charges, charges imposed by other governmental agencies, and collection charges associated with contracted collection agencies shall be levied without returning to Council to amend the collection schedule.
