- 1. For deposit into the State Courthouse Construction fund (SB1407) \$9.50 per citation, as may be increased or decreased;
- For deposit into the Trial Court Trust Fund, \$3.00 per citation, as may be increased or decreased:
- 3. Collection charges assessed by Data Ticket, Inc. including:
 - a. Sixty-cents (\$0.60) per electronic ticket or ninety-cents (\$0.90) per paper citation.
 - b. Citation cost for forms and postage.
 - c. Appeal charges.
 - d. Delinquent fine charge equal to 33% of the delinquent fine.
- 3. Other charges imposed by other governmental agencies.

- 2. All bails and/or fines will be stated in whole dollars with partial dollars being rolled to the next highest dollar.
