This is the fourth project status report for City Council. The last report was provided on November 30, 2010. Since the last report, AWI has completed the placement of the interior rough plumbing within the existing slab, poured footings for the new interior columns, and has continued submitting the required project documentation to the City's Construction Manager (Harris & Associates) for review. AWI has 44 submittal packages and 45 requests for information (RFI's) submitted so far. The number of RFI's, 58, listed in my November report to you was incorrect.

To date there have been no extra work requests, no contract change orders have been approved or requested, and the project is on schedule. AWI has submitted a progress payment request for work totaling \$408,912.23. This request is for work completed through November 30<sup>th</sup> and is subject to a 10 percent retention withholding. The request is currently being routed for approvals and payment has not been made. For the next few weeks the contractor will be working on pouring backing slab utility cuts and preparing the moisture barrier for the new 3" interior slab.

For February's project status report I plan a brief presentation to Council at the February 15<sup>th</sup> Council meeting.
