The Beautification & Appearance Commission held seven (7) regular meetings, between January through December 2016. All regular monthly meetings are held on the second Wednesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. In addition to regular meetings, the Commission held three (3) Special Meetings, (1) joint meeting with the Lompoc City Council and various community events. Total revenue received by the Beautification & Appearance Commission for the 2016 calendar year was \$1,457.49 These contributions are independent funds, generated through public donations, interest income and fund raising. A continued service of the Commission is review of discretionary services provided by Urban Forestry. These services include tree maintenance, planting and removal.
