

RESOLUTION NO. 5623 (10)

**A Resolution Of The City Council Of The City Of Lompoc
County Of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Adopting the Mitigated Negative Declaration
For the Frick Springs Pedestrian Bridge Replacement**

WHEREAS, a request has been made by the Utility Department for City Council consideration of a replacement pedestrian crossing of Miguelito Creek at Frick Springs; and

WHEREAS, a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND ER09-0040) (SCH NO. 2010011027) has been prepared in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and its guidelines and the Environmental Guidelines of the City of Lompoc, to study the environmental impacts of the above request; and

WHEREAS, the MND identifies potentially significant impacts to Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils, Hazardous Waste and Materials, and Hydrology and Water Quality, that can be reduced to a levels of insignificance, with the implementation of the proposed mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, the MND reflects the City of Lompoc's independent judgment and analysis; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed and considered the initial study and any comments received, and finds that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment, with implementation of the identified mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has reviewed and considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration, ER09-0040, received public comments, and considered the written evidence presented in the staff report.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. After review and consideration of the Frick Springs Pedestrian Bridge Replacement MND, considering the evidence and due deliberation of the matters presented, the City Council adopts Mitigated Negative Declaration, ER09-0040 for the Frick Springs Pedestrian Bridge Replacement.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.
