## **RESOLUTION NO. 5477(08)**

A Resolution Of The Council Of The City Of Lompoc County Of Santa Barbara, State of California, Calling And Giving Notice Of The Holding Of A General Municipal Election On Tuesday, November 4, 2008, For The Election Of Certain Officers As Required By The Laws Of The State Of California Relating To General Law Cities

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the law relating to General Law Cities in the State of California, a Consolidated General Municipal election shall be held on November 4, 2008 for the election of Municipal Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California, relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Lompoc, California, on Tuesday, November 4, 2008, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of election of Mayor for the full term of two (2) years; and two (2) Members of the City Council of said City for the full terms of four (4) years.

SECTION 2. The ballots to be used at the election shall be in form and content as required by law.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to procure and furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter, and all supplies, equipment, and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 4. The polls of said election shall be open at seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. of the day of said election and shall remain open continuously from said time until eight o'clock (8:00) p.m. of the same day, when said polls shall be closed, except as provided in Elections Code Section 14401.

SECTION 5. In all particulars not recited in this Resolution, the Election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 6. Notice of the time and place of holding said Election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed, and directed to give such further additional notice of the election, in time, form, and manner as required by law.

SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
