**A Resolution Of The Council Of The City Of Lompoc,
County Of Santa Barbara, State Of California,
Supporting The Filing Of A Grant For A
Job Access/Reverse Commute Grant**

WHEREAS, the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments has identified transit service between Lompoc and the Cities of Buellton and Solvang as an unmet need that is reasonable to meet; and

WHEREAS, a pilot project has been identified to provide transit service between the Cities of Lompoc, Buellton and Solvang; and

WHEREAS, a working group made up of representatives of the Cities of Lompoc, Buellton, Solvang, and the County of Santa Barbara have met and identified operational parameters and additional funding opportunities, such as the Job Access Reverse Commute (JARC) grant, which may provide partial funding for this pilot project; and

WHEREAS, the Aviation/Transportation Administrator for the City of Lompoc has applied for the JARC grant to provide assistance in funding the pilot project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Lompoc supports the application for a Job Access Reverse Commute grant to assist in the operational costs and capital acquisition for a three (3) year pilot project to provide transit service between the Cities of Lompoc, Buellton and Solvang.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.
