**A Resolution Of The Council Of The City Of Lompoc
County Of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Amending Page No. 17 of the City of Lompoc Record Retention Schedule
and Authorizing the Destruction of Certain Obsolete Records
in the Lompoc Police Department**

WHEREAS, the Lompoc Police Department has a critical need for storage space and the Department conducted a review of the City of Lompoc Record Retention Schedule finding that existing law allows for the destruction of certain records within an earlier time frame; and

WHEREAS, the Lompoc Police Department has recently completed an inventory and review of the below listed police records and has determined that they are of no further value to the police department or the City of Lompoc; and

WHEREAS, Section 34090 of the Government Code of the State of California provides that with the approval of the City Council and the written consent of the City Attorney, the head of a city department may destroy any City record, document, instrument, book or paper under his/her charge without making a copy thereof, if the same is no longer required; provided that certain records are exempt from the provisions of said Section, as specifically enumerated in Section 34090 of the Government Code;

WHEREAS, Section 34090.6 of the Government Code of the State of California provides that with the approval of the City Council and with the written consent of the City Attorney, the head of a city department, after one-hundred (100) days, may destroy recordings of routine video monitoring; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has, in accordance with the provisions of 34090 and 34090.6 of the Government Code of the State of California, consented to the destruction of said records and documents as set forth herein below;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Page No. 17 of the City of Lompoc Record Retention Schedule is hereby amended as set forth in [Exhibit "A"](#) attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. That City Council hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to destroy those certain records set forth in [Exhibit "B"](#) attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth herein.
