

RESOLUTION NO. 5514(08)

**A Resolution Of The Council Of The City Of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Authorizing The Reestablishment of Salary
Supplements and Benefits for City Employees
Called to Active Military Duty**

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc City Council authorized, under Resolution No. 5332(06), an extension to December 31, 2008 of the provisions of Resolution Nos. 4968(01) and 5065(03), which provided for military leave salary supplement and benefits to those called into active military duty in response to the War on Terrorism; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Resolution No. 5332(06) will terminate on December 31, 2008; and

WHEREAS, there is an ongoing War on Terrorism and, as a result, more City employees may be called into active military duty in response to this war; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc City Council wishes to reestablish the salary supplement and benefits for eligible employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC RESOLVES THAT:

SECTION 1. Approve the re-establishment of military leave salary supplement and benefits.

SECTION 2. Pay the salary supplement and benefits in accordance with the provisions of Resolution Nos. 4968(01) and 5065(03).

SECTION 3. The effective date of the Resolution shall be January 1, 2009 and continue through December 31, 2010.
