RE: MONUMENT REQUEST IN THE 600 BLOCK OF SOUTH "Z" STREET

Dear Mr. McCune:

I would like to install a monument with a bronze plaque honoring the Mexican pioneers who worked and lived on what used to be the Bodger Seed Company property, now known as Crown Pointe Homes.

The proposed location is in the public right of way, at the south end of the 600 Block of South "Z" Street, one foot behind the back of the public sidewalk and east of the driveway approach going up to what is known as Look Out Point.

The dimensions of the monument are approximately 40" wide by 24" deep by 36" tall. Please find enclosed the inscription on the plaque, a map showing the exact location, and a sketch of the monument.

I have taken your staff's recommendation and have met with the Crown Pointe Garden Society Home Owners Association for their approval. (See the enclosed letter.)

I am aware that if approved by City Council, I will be asked to sign a Maintenance Agreement agreeing to be responsible for the maintenance and up keep of the monument and, if the monument is not maintained in good condition, the monument may be removed.
