A Resolution Of The Council Of The City Of Lompoc County Of Santa Barbara, State of California Approval of the CEQA Environmental Compliance Program For The Lompoc Portion of the Santa Barbara County Annual Action Plan

WHEREAS, the CEQA Environmental Compliance Program (CECP)(HD07-0004) has been prepared as a tool to eliminate repetitious environmental documentation of minor activities that will not have a significant impact on the environment; and

WHEREAS, Section 21084 of CEQA creates Categorical Exemptions and the adopted CEQA guidelines, Section 15301, 15302, 15303, 15304, 15306, 15309, 15311, 15312, 15321, 15322, 15323, 15326, 15330, 15331 and 15332 indicate that activities such as those proposed in the CECP are considered Categorically Exempt; and

WHEREAS, Notices of Exemption have been prepared for the Categorically Exempt activities identified in the CECP; and

WHEREAS, after receiving oral and documentary evidence from City staff and members of the public, the City Council reviewed and considered the evidence, the CECP and the environmental effects of the Lompoc Portion of Santa Barbara County's Annual Action Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Based upon the above-described findings, there is no substantial evidence that the projects included in the 2007-2008 CECP will have a significant effect upon the environment; the CECP (HD07-0004) is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.
