SUBJECT: HANGAR AND TIE-DOWN RENT INCREASES AT THE LOMPOC

**AIRPORT** 

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That Council receive staff input, take public testimony and approve Resolution No. 5389(07), which increases fees for hangar and tie-down rentals at the Lompoc Airport effective July 1, 2007.

#### **BACKGROUND AND/OR DISCUSSION:**

At the May 17, 2005, City Council Meeting, Council approved Resolution No. 5254(05), which increased rental fees for both hangars and tie-down area over the next two years. The final rental fee increase became effective July 1, 2006.

The Airport budget is faced with ongoing financial challenges. In order to develop a reserve for future infrastructure needs such as runway and taxiway relighting, overlays, fencing and security needs, as well as building and other repair needs, airport rental rates will have to be increased.

Current hangar rates are also well below market rate as evidenced by the rental rate for newly built T-hangars at the Lompoc Airport which are renting for \$330 to \$390 per month. Monthly T-hangar rates at Santa Barbara are \$450-\$820 per month; Santa Ynez - \$190-\$380 per month; and Santa Maria - \$160 per month.

Monthly rental fees will increase approximately 5 percent, or \$7.00 to \$10.00 per month, effective July 1, and another 5 percent effective July 1, 2006, for City owned hangars. Monthly fees for tie-downs will also increase by approximately 5 percent.

WHEREAS, after hearing public testimony and Staff's report and recommendation, the City Council has determined that the proposed new fees are necessary to help offset the costs incurred by the City of Lompoc in operating the Lompoc Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 308 of the Lompoc City Code, the following rental fees are hereby established:
