SUBJECT: AUTHORIZATION FOR DISPOSAL OF CITY OWNED SIDEARMS SCHEDULED TO BE REPLACED

Recommendation: that the City Council:

1. Authorize officers of the Lompoc Police Department to purchase city owned Smith and Wesson duty handguns that are scheduled to be replaced with new Glock duty handguns.
2. Authorize the Police Department to trade in remaining handguns to L.C. Action Police Supply towards the purchase of the new handgun inventory.

Background:


The City Council recently approved a budget which included replacement of the Department's aging handgun inventory. The line item approved took into account a trade in value for the existing handguns of \$8,241. A new inventory of pistols will be provided from L.C. Action Police Supply.

Many of the Department's old Smith & Wesson model 5903 handguns are stamped with "LOMPOC PD" on the frame. Because of this, officers have expressed a feeling of sentimentality for these handguns and a desire to purchase the duty sidearm which they personally carried.

Under this proposal officers would be given the opportunity to purchase their issued Smith & Wesson handgun and two spare magazines. Two separate gun vendors have placed the fair market value of the guns and magazines at \$201.00 each. Ownership transfer paperwork as required by law will be handled by a local federal firearms dealer. In addition to the fair market value of the gun, each officer will be charged the required dealers registration of sale fee. No officer will be permitted to purchase more than one handgun.

The Department intends to retain a few of the remaining handguns for historical and training purposes. Approval is further requested to trade the remaining inventory in to L.C. Action Police Supply at \$201 each for a credit against the purchase of the new handgun inventory.

JUSTIFICATION FOR REQUEST
 The duty weapons currently used by Lompoc Police officers were purchased in 1984. As a result of their age, a number of these firearms are in disrepair. Duty firearm malfunctions are increasing during range training and some of the firearms inventory have questionable reliability. This request is to purchase new handguns for every sworn officer at the Lompoc Police Department. Duty weapons are state mandated as safety equipment. The current firearms are over twenty years old and due for replacement. Ten firearms will be retained for training purposes and the remaining inventory will be traded in or sold to officers.
