

RESOLUTION NO. 6243(19)

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Creating a Permit Parking Program on Cordoba Avenue and Aviation Drive

WHEREAS, Lompoc Municipal Code section 10.28.040(B) prohibits parking on Cordoba Avenue and Aviation Drive between the hours of 11:00 p.m. on any one day and 6:00 a.m. on the next day; and

WHEREAS, Lompoc Municipal Code section 10.28.230 authorizes the City Council, by resolution, to establish a parking permit program, pursuant to Vehicle Code section 22507, which allows designated individuals to park in restricted parking zones when in possession of a City-issued permit; and

WHEREAS, the City is informed that the parking lot immediately south of Aviation Drive with Assessor's Parcel Number 093-450-054 is operated by the Chumash Casino Resort as a park and ride lot for people commuting to the Chumash Casino Resort, and that Resort employees and other patrons of the park and ride lot are sometimes required to park on Aviation Drive when there are no available spaces in the park and ride lot; and

WHEREAS, the City is informed that employees, patrons, and guests of other adjacent businesses may need to park on Cordoba Avenue and Aviation Drive for legitimate business purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that allowing employees, patrons, and guests of adjacent businesses to park on Cordoba Avenue and Aviation Drive would benefit the businesses, would not be inconsistent with the purpose of the overnight parking ban on those streets, and will not adversely affect parking conditions for residents and merchants in the area.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The overnight parking restrictions on Cordoba Avenue and Aviation Drive, established in Lompoc Municipal Code section 10.28.040(B)(1) and (B)(2), shall not apply to any vehicle displaying a valid parking permit, issued by the City, on the dashboard on the driver's side of the vehicle, or otherwise made clearly visible; provided, such vehicle is in compliance with the other provisions of this resolution and the provisions of the Lompoc Municipal Code.

SECTION 2. Any business operating, or owning property, immediately adjacent to Cordoba Avenue or Aviation Drive may request and shall receive from the City, upon payment of the fee set by the City Council, as many parking permits as may be reasonably necessary for its business needs.

SECTION 3. Each parking permit issued pursuant to this resolution shall clearly state it is only valid for parking on Cordoba Avenue and Aviation Drive, and shall clearly state the

name of the business to which it was issued.

SECTION 4. Business owners may distribute their permits in accordance with their business needs, provided that permits shall only be given to employees, patrons, and guests of the business. Business owners shall not exchange or share their permits with any other business.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be effective immediately, but shall not be enforced until the effective date of Ordinance No.1666(19).
