

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lompoc Planning Commission will conduct a special public hearing on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>March 27</u>, <u>2019</u> at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 100 Civic Center Plaza, to consider the following item:

A request for a 2-year time extension for the Towbes residential development at Burton Ranch Vesting Tentative Map (LOM 570)

A request for Planning Commission consideration of a two-year time extension for Vesting Tentative Map LOM 570 for the Towbes residential development at Burton Ranch to subdivide an approximately 100.9 acre site into 229 parcels. The proposed project site is located at the intersection of Harris Grade Road and Highway 1 within the Burton Ranch Specific Plan (SP) Zoning District. (Assessor Parcel Numbers: 097-250-050, 097-250-051, 097-250-083, and 097-250-0084). This action is categorically exempt pursuant to Section 65457of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as the proposal is consistent with the adopted Burton Ranch Specific Plan for which a Program Environmental Impact Report (SCH#2002091045) was previously certified. An addendum for the time extension has been prepared pursuant to CEQA.

Any person may appeal a decision of the Planning Commission to the City Council within ten (10) calendar days, or as otherwise specified in the City Code, from the date of the decision. If the Planning Commission action is a recommendation, the action will be heard by the City Council and no appeal is necessary. The appeal fee is \$257.80.
