Conditional Use Permit for a Fifteen Unit Apartment Complex (CUP 18-04) Continued from February 27, 2019

A request from Tony Tomasello of RRM Design Group representing the Housing Authority of the County of Santa Barbara (property owner) for Planning Commission consideration of a proposal for a fifteen unit apartment complex. The project site is 0.39 acres and is located at 1401 East Cypress Avenue (APN: 085-150-089) in the Commercial Office (CO) zoning district. This action is categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15332 (In-fill Development Projects) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Any person may appeal a decision of the Planning Commission to the City Council within ten (10) calendar days, or as otherwise specified in the City Code, from the date of the decision. If the Planning Commission action is a recommendation, the action will be heard by the City Council and no appeal is necessary. The appeal fee is \$257.80. Pursuant to Government Code requirements this agenda is posted 72 hours in advance of the meeting in the lobby of City Hall and in the Lompoc Library.
