  - i. Change the Zoning Map designation for one parcel (APN: 085-150-089) at the northwest corner of Seventh Street and Cypress Avenue from Commercial Office (CO) to Medium Density Residential (R2); and
  - ii. Change the Zoning Map designation of a portion of one parcel (APN: 085-150-090) at the southwest corner of Seventh Street and Ocean Avenue from CO to High Density Residential (R3);
- g) Introduce through first reading by title only with further reading waived, Ordinance No. 1670(19), which will:
  - Delete LMC section 10.28.150 relating to permit requirements for commercial vehicles used for solicitation of patronage;
  - ii. Delete the CO designation from the City's zoning map and Zoning Code, rename the C2 (Central Business) zoning designation to CB (Central Business), rename the T (Mobile Home Park) zoning designation to MH (Residential Mobile Home Park);
