SOCIAL SCENE- This month's dance had 18 participants and was themed "Cinco de Mayo". All of the participants enjoyed dinner and had a great time dancing the night away.

ADULT CLASSES - Six adult classes were held during the month of May with 32 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS - There were a total of 37 Park rentals this month, 24 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 27 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and seven rentals at the Civic Auditorium.

SENIOR PROGRAMS and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals. ADULT SPORTS- The Adult softball program continued with games being held for Men on Thursdays and Coed on Sundays at both Ryon and Thompson parks. We have over 440 individual participants in the program.
