RULING ON REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION


Dear Mr. Mendoza:

Your letter of March 25, 2019, has been determined to consist of a "request for reconsideration" under the Lompoc Municipal Code (LMC) section 13.16.140. As such, I have reviewed your request for reconsideration and provide the following response.

The LMC at section 13.16.370 allows the Utility Director the discretion to determine whether traps/interceptors to capture grease are required in restaurants and other businesses in order to protect the City's wastewater system. I have reviewed the information you provided and found it does not negate the need for a grease trap to be installed at La Roca Taqueria and Bakery.

For that reason, your request for reconsideration is denied.

You may appeal my ruling to the City Council by submitting a written appeal to the City Clerk within 10 working days. That appeal shall be heard and decided by the City Council at a regular City Council meeting held within 60 days after receipt of your request. (LMC 13.16.140)
