

RESOLUTION NO. 6283(19)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Approving Closure of City Hall and Suspension of Certain
Field Operations on December 23, 26, and 27, 2019**

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) City Hall and the Library (including Vandenberg Village) will be closed and selected City field operations will be suspended during the Christmas Eve and Christmas Day holiday observances on Tuesday and Wednesday, December 24-25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, City Hall and the Library (including Vandenberg Village) will be closed and selected City field operations will be suspended during the New Year's Day holiday observance on Wednesday, January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, City Hall, the Library (including Vandenberg Village) and selected City field operations may experience an anticipated reduction in customer-driven workload on Monday, Thursday, and Friday, December 23, 26, and 27, 2019; and

WHEREAS, as one of several strategies to balance the Biennial Budget Fiscal Years 2019-21, the City Council approved the concept of encouraging voluntary furloughs among employees in certain situations where workforce hours could be reduced without significant impact on service levels; and

WHEREAS, several City employees plan for and/or would prefer to take time off during the holidays to be with family and friends.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. City Hall and the Library (including Vandenberg Village) will be closed and certain City field operations shall be suspended on December 23, 26, and 27, 2019.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
