WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 6086(17) authorizing the City Manager and Management Services Director to finance the demolition of the Municipal Pool complex for up to \$750,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City has financed this Project since February 2017 for \$750,000, has been paying on the debt service, and has a remaining balance outstanding of \$578.460.

WHEREAS, the City has now received bids for construction of the Project, and has established a total Project budget of \$472,650.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to appropriate funds to provide for the completion of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Lompoc hereby agrees and further does authorize the City Manager or designee to expend funds for the Project.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the supplemental appropriation of Fiscal Year 2019-20 funds from available resources for the Project as follows:
