# LOMPOC RECREATION DIVISION STAFF REPORT September 2019

**SOCIAL SCENE -** This month's dance had 26 participants and was themed "Lompoc vs. Cabrillo". All of the participants enjoyed dinner and had a great time dancing the night away.

**ADULT CLASSES** – Six adult classes were held during the month of August with 46 participants.

**FACILITY RENTALS -** There were a total of 36 Park rentals this month, 17 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 12 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and five rentals at the Civic Auditorium.

**SENIOR PROGRAMS** and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals.

**YOUTH CLASSES/PROGRAMS-** There were five youth and teen programs/camps offered this month with 44 registrations.

**MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS-** There were 124 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 89 Passport Photos processed.

**ADULT SPORTS-** The Fall Adult Softball Program started with games being held for men on Thursdays and Coed on Sundays at both Ryon and Thompson Parks. Over 400 individual participants in the program.

**VEHICLE RENTALS** – We provided bus transportation for the Vandenberg Air Force Base airmen on September 8; Special Olympics to Los Osos on the 14<sup>th</sup>; a local wine tasting on the 22<sup>nd</sup>; and a private birthday party to Santa Maria on the 28<sup>th</sup>. We provided transportation for a funeral reception shuttle on the 14<sup>th</sup> and Special Olympics to Ventura on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
