

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lompoc Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 13</u>, <u>2019</u> at 6:30 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 100 Civic Center Plaza, to consider the following item:

Conditional Use Permit (CUP 19-05) for Hometown Pharmacy to establish a drive through window.

A request for a Conditional Use Permit from Joseph Abraham (applicant/owner) for Planning Commission consideration for the establishment of a drive through window at an existing Pharmacy located at 414 and 410 North H Street (APN's: 087-242-011 and 087-242-010) on a 0.35 acre site within the Central Business (C2) zone. This action is categorically exempt pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

Any person may appeal a decision of the Planning Commission to the City Council within ten (10) calendar days, or as otherwise specified in the City Code, from the date of the decision. If the Planning Commission action is a recommendation, the action will be heard by City Council and no appeal is needed. The appeal fee is \$257.80.
