SOCIAL SCENE - This month's dance had 33 participants and was themed "Movie Night". All of the participants enjoyed dinner and had a great time dancing the night away.

ADULT CLASSES – four adult classes were held during the month of October with 17 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS - There were a total of 32 Park rentals this month, 14 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 11 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and three rentals at the Civic Auditorium.

SENIOR PROGRAMS and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals.

ADULT SPORTS- The Fall Adult Softball program ended with games being held for Men on Thursdays and Coed on Sundays at both Ryon and Thompson Parks. We had over 400 individuals in the program.

YOUTH SPORTS – We currently have 243 athletes registered for our Youth Basketball program with games that began on November 23rd.
