

RESOLUTION NO. 6293 (19)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Adopting a Provisional Business Tax Certificate Procedure
Pursuant to Senate Bill 205**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 205 (SB 205) was signed into law by the Governor of the State of California on October 2, 2019;

WHEREAS, SB 205 requires cities to review Business Tax Certificate (BTC) applications and BTC renewals beginning January 1, 2020, to determine if the applicant is subject to the Statewide Industrial General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Industrial Activities (IGP);

WHEREAS, SB 205 provides a city may develop a provisional license procedure allowing businesses seeking to renew an existing BTC to obtain a provisional BTC renewal for a period of three months, during which the business can submit the storm water permitting information required by Senate Bill 205; and

WHEREAS, the additional three months' time will assist businesses in retaining their BTC with the City if they are in need of additional time to obtain the storm water permitting information required by Senate Bill 205.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Any applicant for a BTC renewal in the calendar year 2020 who does not submit the information required by Senate Bill 205 with its BTC renewal application shall be issued a provisional BTC, provided the applicant complies with all other requirements for BTC renewal. The provisional BTC shall expire three months after the date it is issued. Any holder of an unexpired provisional BTC may submit to the City Clerk the information required by Senate Bill 205, in the required form and under penalty of perjury. Upon determination by the City Clerk that the information submitted complies with Senate Bill 205, the City Clerk shall issue the provisional BTC holder a non-provisional BTC.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the first day of January, 2020.
