A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Adoption of the City of Lompoc Wildfire Mitigation Plan

WHEREAS, Senate Bill (SB) 901 was adopted in 2018, amending California Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 8387, to require all publicly-owned electric utilities before January 1, 2020, to prepare a wildfire mitigation plan annually; and

WHEREAS, on January 19, 2018, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) adopted a statewide CPUC Fire-Threat Map to identify areas where there is an increased risk for utility-associated wildfires and Lompoc Electric has identified that less than 2% of its utility's infrastructure is located in and adjacent to a CPUC designated Tier 2 High Fire Threat District; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc Wildfire Mitigation Plan complies with SB 901 and considers all of the requirements outlined in PUC Section 8387(b)(2).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby adopts the City of Lompoc Wildfire Mitigation Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.
