

**RESOLUTION NO. 6292(19)**

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,  
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,  
Adoption of the City of Lompoc Wildfire Mitigation Plan**

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill (SB) 901 was adopted in 2018, amending California Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 8387, to require all publicly-owned electric utilities before January 1, 2020, to prepare a wildfire mitigation plan annually; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 19, 2018, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) adopted a statewide CPUC Fire-Threat Map to identify areas where there is an increased risk for utility-associated wildfires and Lompoc Electric has identified that less than 2% of its utility's infrastructure is located in and adjacent to a CPUC designated Tier 2 High Fire Threat District; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lompoc Wildfire Mitigation Plan complies with SB 901 and considers all of the requirements outlined in PUC Section 8387(b)(2).

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby adopts the City of Lompoc Wildfire Mitigation Plan attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2.** Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
