STAFF REPORT
December 2019

ADULT CLASSES – 3 adult class were held during the month of December with 11 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS - There were a total of 11 Park rentals this month, 27 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 10 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and six rentals at the Civic Auditorium.

SENIOR PROGRAMS and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals.

YOUTH CLASSES/PROGRAMS- There were six youth and teen programs offered, including a Cookie Deco Workshop and a Lompoc Youth Theater holiday program, with over 41 participants.

The Santa Visits this year was a success, with nine visits scheduled the weekend of December 13, 2019. This program utilizes a volunteer Santa and serves as a fundraiser for our scholarship program.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS- There were 106 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 63 Passport Photos processed.

YOUTH SPORTS – We currently have 243 athletes participating in the Youth Basketball Program with games held during the week and Saturdays at the Anderson Rec Center, LVMS, VMS, and CHS.

EXCURSIONS – We held an excursion to Cambria Hearst Castle for the Christmas decorations that attracted 18 participants.

ADULT SPORTS – Drop-in Pickleball continued every Tuesday and Thursday at the Anderson Rec Center.

SPECIAL EVENTS

The Lompoc Valley Children's Christmas Season Parade was a success with 60 entries and over 1,500 participants. Santa Claus was available afterwards at Centennial Park to visit with the children.

The next morning, there was a Breakfast with Santa held at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center, with over 120 people in attendance. Pancakes and sausage were served, along with hot cocoa and a special visit from Santa.
