Subject: RE: PDT summary for Director Mosby

The effort to prepare a Project Initiation Document (PID) was kicked off on April 28th 2020. The meeting included representatives from SBCAG, County of Santa Barbara and the City of Lompoc. The project proposes to replace the Robinson Bridge on Route 246 over the Santa Ynez River and to construct a capital-maintenance project to extend the life of the pavement between the Lompoc City limits and Domingos Rd., and bring it up to good condition. The bridge will include standard lanes, shoulders and barrier separated pedestrian paths in both directions. Anticipated approval of the PID is in January 2021 with the scope of the project identified and an estimate and schedule determined. The project is intended to be programmed in the 2022 SHOPP. The bridge may require the project to go to construction beyond fiscal year 25/26. There are right-of-way and utility relocation challenges.
