February 2020

ADULT CLASSES – 6 adult class were held during the month of February with 53 participants.

FACILITY RENTALS - There were a total of 10 Park rentals this month, 13 rentals at the Anderson Recreation Center, 12 rentals at the Dick DeWees Community and Senior Center, and four rentals at the Civic Auditorium.

SENIOR PROGRAMS and related services take place daily at the Dick DeWees Community & Senior Center (DDCSC) on a Monday through Friday basis, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. After 3:00 p.m. weekdays, and as available on weekends, the DDCSC is utilized for instructional classes, special events, meetings, and facility rentals.

YOUTH CLASSES/PROGRAMS- There were seven youth and teen programs offered this month and during the school February break we held a teen camp called “Summer Employment Workshop for Teens” with 40 teens registered. After camp concluded, the participants were provided an opportunity to be interviewed for employment. Another camp offered was Lompoc Youth Theater’s “Gold Dust or Bust”. The camp had 13 participants and concluded with a public performance for all to enjoy.

This month was the Annual Father Daughter Dance that had an overwhelming response, selling out on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Over the course of the weekend, the event had over 400 girls and their dates.

MISCELLANEOUS PROGRAMS- There were 146 passports that were processed at the Anderson Recreation Center this month and 87 Passport Photos processed.

YOUTH SPORTS – 4 Youth Evolution Basketball classes were held during the month of February with 21 total participants. We had 243 athletes participating in the Youth Basketball Program with games held during the week and Saturdays at the Anderson Rec Center, LVMS, VMS, and CHS. We also had the 3rd/4th girls and boys all-star teams compete in the Santa Maria tournament as well as the 5th/6th grade girls all-stars.

ADULT SPORTS – Drop-in Pickleball continued every Tuesday and Thursday at the Anderson Rec Center.

VEHICLE RENTALS – We had a nus rental to Bakersfield for Special Olympics. We also had a rental for bike park volunteers during the month.
