A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Approving Supplemental Appropriations and Supplemental Revenues for a Measure A Bicycle and Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Program Project

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) desires to provide safe and efficient transportation infrastructure and planning for pedestrian travel within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a North County Measure A Bicycle and Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Program Cycle 3 funding grant in the amount of \$45,000 for the construction of missing sidewalk and a pedestrian Railroad Crossing at the southwest corner of A Street and Cypress Avenue (Project); and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2020, the City Council approved execution of a Cooperative Agreement with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG) in order to accept the \$45,000 of grant funds and commit \$10,000 from City transportation funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has available Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 3 revenues which it receives annually, and which can only be spent for the benefit of pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to appropriate funds for the completion of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:
