- The Lompoc Fire Department was established on August 31, 1875
- In 1891 Fire Station / City Hall
- Current facility resides on this original site

 - 1977, Remodel 6,500 SQ FT
- Middle Section
 - 1957, 2,300 SQ FT
- Old Jail
 - 1920 1950, 500 SQ FT



EVALUATION AND REQUESTS

- 2007 Robert Olsen & Assoc. Fire Protection Services for the City of Lompoc: Planning for the Future.
- 2013 Fire Service Master Plan
 - Identified performance measures and infrastructure needs.
- 2014 Ehlen Spiess and Haight, Inc. Seismic Evaluation
 - "The building is very likely to be partially or completely non-functional as a fire station." June 23rd, 2014
- 2014 Frank Schipper Construction Co. Seismic Retrofit Rough Order of Magnitude Statement of Probable
 Cost and Conceptual Schedule: estimated at \$3.2 million

EVALUATION AND REQUESTS

- 2015 Grant submissions for retrofit of station
- 2015 Review and design of new fire station
- 2019 Cal OES notification of funding denied
 - "Project is ineligible because it is neither feasible nor effective as a long-term solution"
- 2019 Earthquake in December, new cracks and shifting noticed.
 - Ehlen Spiess & Haight, Inc. Structural Condition Assessment
 - "No imminent safety concern."
 - "Current scope of work does not include evaluation of seismic compliance issues."
