RESOLUTION NO. 6389(21)

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Establishing 10-Year Energy Efficiency Savings Targets

WHEREAS, California Assembly Bill 2021 (AB 2021) requires all electric publicly owned utilities (POUs) to identify all potentially achievable, cost-effective, energy efficiency savings and establish annual targets for energy efficiency savings and demand reduction for a 10-year period, every three years beginning 2007; and

WHEREAS, AB 2021 requires all POUs to report adopted energy savings targets to the California Energy Commission; and

WHEREAS, California Assembly Bill 2227 (AB 2227) added Subsection 9505(b) to the Public Utilities Code (PUC), changing the timeframe of AB 2021 to identify all potentially achievable, cost-effective efficiency savings and establish annual targets and demand reduction for a 10-year period from every three years to every four years beginning in 2017; and

WHEREAS, Northern California Power Agency, Southern California Public Power Agency and California Municipal Utilities Association contracted with GDS Associates, Inc. (GDS) to assist in establishing energy efficiency savings targets for all members; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) utilized the modeling tool created by GDS to establish the potential annual energy efficiency savings targets with a total savings of 2,616 megawatt-hours (MWh), over a 10-year period, beginning in 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City adopts the 10-year energy efficiency savings targets developed by GDS, attached hereto as Exhibit A, to ensure the City meets the requirements of Subsection 9505(b) of the PUC.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
