A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, Authorizing the Filing of the Claim to the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments for Allocation of Transportation Development Act Funds for FY 2021-22

WHEREAS, the Transportation Development Act (TDA), as amended (Public Utilities Code sections 99200 *et seq.*), provides for the allocation of funds from the Local Transportation Fund (LTF) for use by eligible claimants for various transportation purposes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the TDA, as amended, and pursuant to the applicable rules and regulations thereunder (21 California Code of Regulations sections 6600 *et seq.*), a prospective claimants in Santa Barbara County wishing to receive an allocation from the LTF or State Transit Assistance Fund (STA) must file its claim or amended claim with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute and file an appropriate claim attached hereto as Exhibit A and necessary claim amendments pursuant to the terms of the TDA, as amended, and pursuant to applicable rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, together with all necessary supporting documents, with SBCAG for an allocation of TDA funds in Fiscal Year 2021-22.

SECTION 2. The authorized claim includes \$54,201.00 for Regional Transportation Planning, \$36,872.00 for Pedestrian and Bicycle Facilities, and \$2,207,213.00 for Transit Purposes.

SECTION 3. A copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted to SBCAG in conjunction with the filing of the claim.
