BLACK GOLD COOPERATIVE LIBRARY SYSTEM

Black Gold Cooperative Library System meetings are attended on an ongoing basis. These include: Administrative Council, Reference and Adult Services, Youth Services, and Automated and Technical Services. All meetings have moved online over the last year. There has been much discussion about changing the existing library catalog to better assist patrons and a new overlay is in the works. Searching for items will be easier as all titles in all formats will be shown together. For example, if a patron searches for Anne of Green Gables, they will see the book, the audiobook, the movie, the television show, and all digital resources on the same screen so they will not need to narrow their search. This change should be implemented in the next six months.

COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA LIBRARY SERVICES

The Library Advisory Committee continues to meet on a quarterly basis. The LAC ad hoc committee working on budget recommendations and the funding situation will continue to meet at least once a month for the 20/21 fiscal year. Members of the ad hoc committee will be focusing on benchmarks for county libraries and a possible tax measure.

The library director continues to work closely with the county to secure better funding for the Lompoc libraries. There has been discussion by the Santa Barbara Library of leaving the Black Gold catalog and the county system. No decisions have been made at this time. Carpentaria Library is in the process of creating their own library to operate independently from the Santa Barbara Library and this should take place in July 2022.

- Relocated Juvenile collections for ease of use (Village)
- Distributed book giveaways at Meals on Wheels, Partners in Caring, Recovery Way Home and LUSD lunch sites
- Presented month-long Halloween programming online
- Through Beanstack, have created 13 challenges, with 652 participants to date
- Starting in November, monthly outreach program with painted rocks hidden in different areas around community
- Staff attended all virtual California State Library meetings and other trainings as available
- Promoted new digital resources made available through the California State Library (Brainfuse JobNow/VetNow, Britannica School, Britannica Escolar, The New York Times, TeachingBooks.net)
- Basement was organized and received update lighting (Lompoc)
- Upgraded payment system and replaced cash register (Lompoc)
