## **RESOLUTION NO. 6401(21)**

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Authorizing City Staff to Execute the Certifications and Assurances and
Any Other Documents for the Low Carbon Transit Operations
Program for the Transit Operations Center and
Fleet Maintenance Facility Renewable Energy
And Related Budget Appropriations

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 862 (2014) named Department of Transportation (Department) as the administrative agency for the Low Carbon Transit Operations Program (LCTOP); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lompoc (City) is an eligible project sponsor and may receive state funding from the LCTOP for transit projects; and

WHEREAS, the statutes related to state-funded transit projects require a local or regional implementing agency to abide by various regulations and reporting requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department has developed guidelines for the purpose of administering and distributing LCTOP funds to eligible project sponsors (local agencies), such as the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to appropriate the estimated revenue equal to the funding formulas provided by the Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to delegate authorization to execute those documents, any amendments, and any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining LCTOP funding provided by the Department thereto to either the City Manager, Public Works Director, Assistant Public Works Director, or Aviation/Transportation Administrator, and

**WHEREAS**, The City wishes to implement the LCTOP project listed above.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The City of Lompoc as funding recipient agrees to comply with all conditions and requirements set forth in the Certification and Assurances document and applicable statutes, regulations and guidelines for all LCTOP funded transit projects.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager, Public Works Director, Assistant Public Works Director, and the Aviation/Transportation Administrator are each authorized to execute in the name of the City, all necessary and required assurances, applications, contracts, agreements, amendments (with those last three subject to City Attorney approval as to form), payment requests, and related documents for the purposes of securing LCTOP funding with the Department and implementing and carrying out the purposes specified in the grant application.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council authorizes submittal of the following project nomination and allocation request to the Department in FY 2020-21 LCTOP funds:

Name: Transit Operations and Fleet Maintenance Facility Renewable Energy

Funding: \$112,450 in 99313 and \$981 in 99314

Description: Installation of Photovoltaic (Solar) renewable energy system.

**SECTION 4.** Supplemental estimated revenues and related supplemental appropriations are approved as follows:
