A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Adopting Substantial Amendment No. 2 to the FY 2019-2020
CDBG Annual Action Plan, Approving Funding of the
Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus
Access Lompoc Program, and Authorizing the
City Manager to Sign Any Required Agreements

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), signed in March 2020 authorized Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV3) Funds made available from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to be allocated to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) has been allocated CDBG-CV3 funding in the amount of \$394,259; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2021, the City Council held a public hearing and received public input concerning allocation of the CDBG-CV3 funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt a Substantial Amendment to Fiscal Year (FY) 2019-20 Community Development Block Grant Action Plan (2019-2020 Action Plan) to include CDBG-CV3 funding for a COVID-19 prevention, preparation and response program (Access Lompoc Program); and

WHEREAS, in response to the growing effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic, including the closure of Lompoc facilities and programs to the public, the City Council wishes to implement the CDBG-CV3 Funding for an Access Lompoc Program designed to assist in the safe opening of Lompoc facilities and programs used by the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1.** Substantial Amendment No. 2 to the 2019-2020 Action Plan (attached hereto as Exhibit A) is hereby adopted.
- **SECTION 2.** The CDBG-CV3 funds shall be used for a FY 2019-20 Access Lompoc Program in accordance with the statutes and regulations of the CDBG-CV and HUD.
- **SECTION 3**. The City Manager or designee is authorized to sign any agreements or certifications required to conduct the Access Lompoc Program.
- **SECTION 4**. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
