**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Adopting a Santa Barbara County Phase II Community Action
Plan to Address Homelessness**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lompoc (City) has received a presentation by Santa Barbara County (County) on homelessness in the County, including a report on the Phase II Community Action Plan to Address Homelessness (Plan), which identifies key strategies and priority areas to address homelessness and ensures compliance with State of California requirements by demonstrating a regional planning process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the proposed adoption of the Plan does not constitute the approval of a "project" subject to environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), finding the adoption of the Plan is an administrative action of government that in itself will not result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt the County's Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Phase II Community Action Plan to Address Homelessness attached as Exhibit A is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
