SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution No. 6421(21) Repealing Resolution No. 6408(21) and Declaring the City Council's Intention to Levy Assessments for Fiscal Year 2021-22, Preliminarily Approving an Engineer's Report and Providing Notice of a Public Hearing for the Park Maintenance and City Pool Assessment District No. 2002-01

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the City Council take the following actions:

- 1) Adopt Resolution No. 6421(21) (Attachment 1):
 - a. Repealing Resolution No. 6408(21); and
 - b. Declaring the City Council's intention to again levy the annual park and pool assessments for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 and schedule public hearing for the same,
 - c. Preliminarily approving the Engineer's Report (Attachment 2), and
 - d. Providing notice of a public hearing on July 6, 2021, for the proposed continuation of the assessments for the Park Maintenance and City Pool Assessment District No. 2002-01 (District), in order to receive public input on:
 - i. The proposed continuation of the assessments;
 - ii. The proposed assessment budget for FY 2021-22; and
 - iii. The services and improvements of the assessments fund, and any other issues related to the assessments.

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Adoption of Resolution No. 6421(21) and Setting of Public Hearing on July 6, 2021

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Background/Discussion:

On May 18, 2021, Resolution No. 6408(21) was adopted, which declared the City Council's intention to levy the annual assessments, approved the Engineer's Report, and provided notice of a public hearing on June 15, 2021. Unfortunately, due to changes made by the Lompoc Record with respect to publishing of legal notices, the public hearing notice was not sent to the newspaper in time for it to be published 10 days before the hearing date of June 15, 2021. To correct this issue, the resolution must be repealed and a new resolution adopted with a new hearing date so that it can be noticed appropriately 10 days in advance.

Fiscal Impact:

The expected costs of preparing the Engineer's Report by SCI Consulting Group is included in the Biennial Budget FYs 2021-23 from the Assessment District fund, a non-General Fund source. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact to the General Fund attributable to the approval of this item. There are no additional costs with respect to repealing and replacing Resolution No. 6408(21) in order to properly notice the public hearing.

Conclusion:

With the adoption of Resolution No. 6421(21), the public hearing will be noticed timely, the proposed assessment budget for FY 2021-22, and the services and improvements made possible by the assessment funds can be accomplished. Receipt of the assessments will continue to provide important revenues needed to fund the community swimming pool, as well as other park and recreation improvements and services.
