

RESOLUTION NO. 6428(21)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Approving Supplemental Appropriations and Supplemental
Revenues for Consultant Services Related to
Redistricting Following the 2020 Census**

WHEREAS, On December 19, 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1643(17), establishing a district-based system for elections for members of the City Council commencing with the General Municipal Election in November 2018; and

WHEREAS, with the completion of the 2020 Census, the City is now required to adopt district boundaries based on the 2020 Census information; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code Section 21607.1 requires the City must conduct at least one (1) Public Hearing before maps are drawn and at least two (2) Public Hearings after draft maps are drawn, at which time the public is invited to provide input regarding the composition of the districts; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to utilize the services of a consultant to complete the redistricting process; and

WHEREAS, the City has contracted with National Demographics as its demographer; and

WHEREAS, the cost of demographer services is \$21,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lompoc (City) now wishes to approve appropriations for \$21,000 for National Demographics to act as its demographer and to advise them concerning redistricting of City Districts following the 2020 Census on July 6, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. To approve budget appropriations for the demographer approved at the July 6, 2021, City Council meeting and related revenue or reserves as follows:
